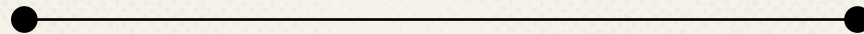

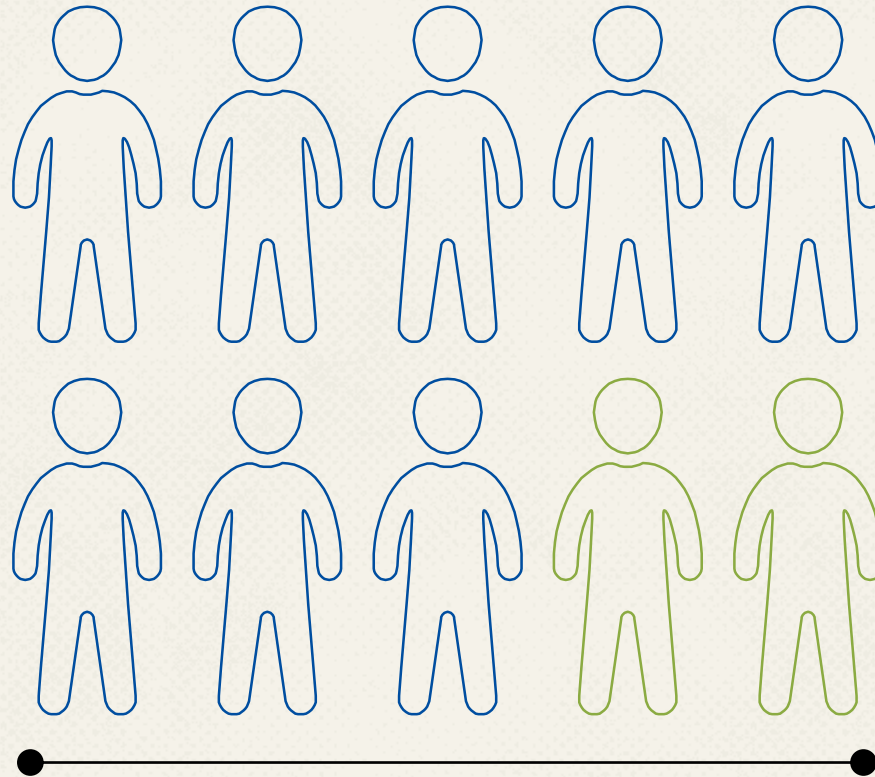

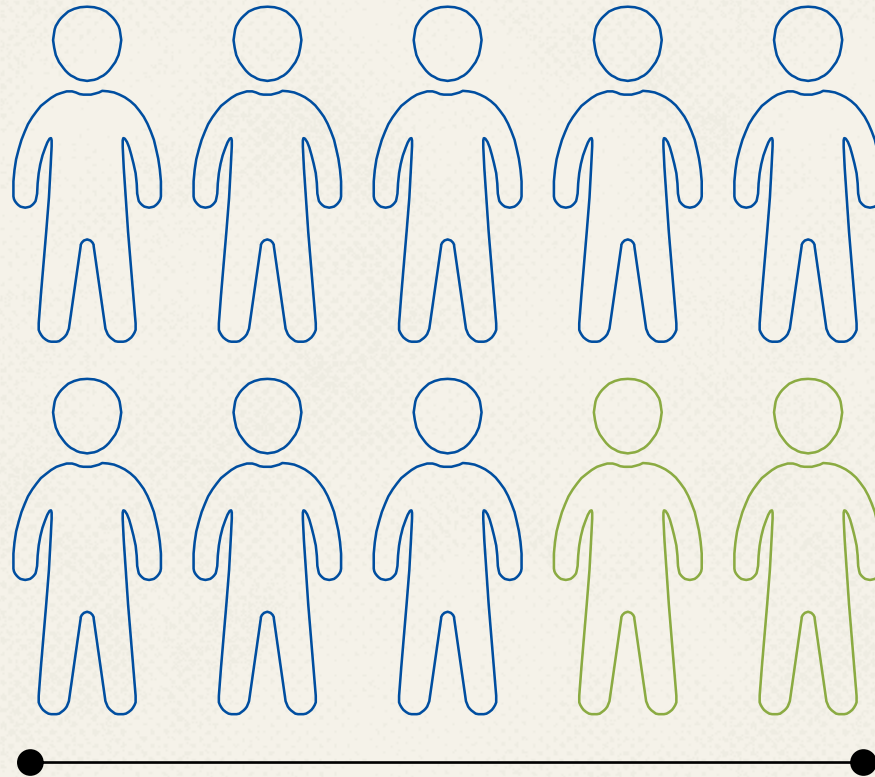

Provide **free English & non-cognitive skills training** for people in Delhi and UP.

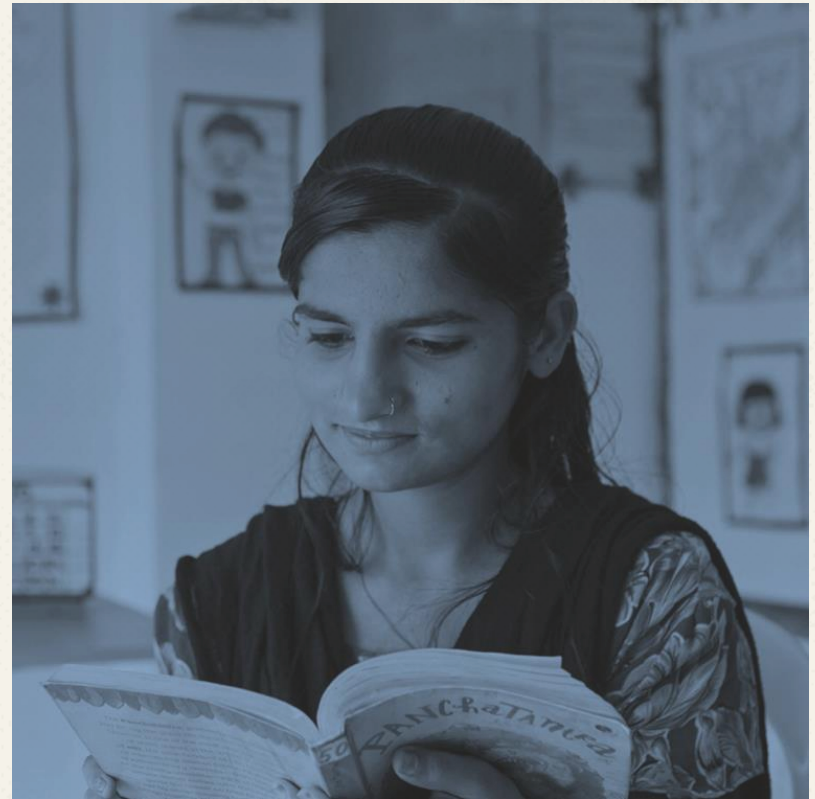
Teach English and skills development to **those who need it but have no access.**

Prove the model then proactively help others replicate.

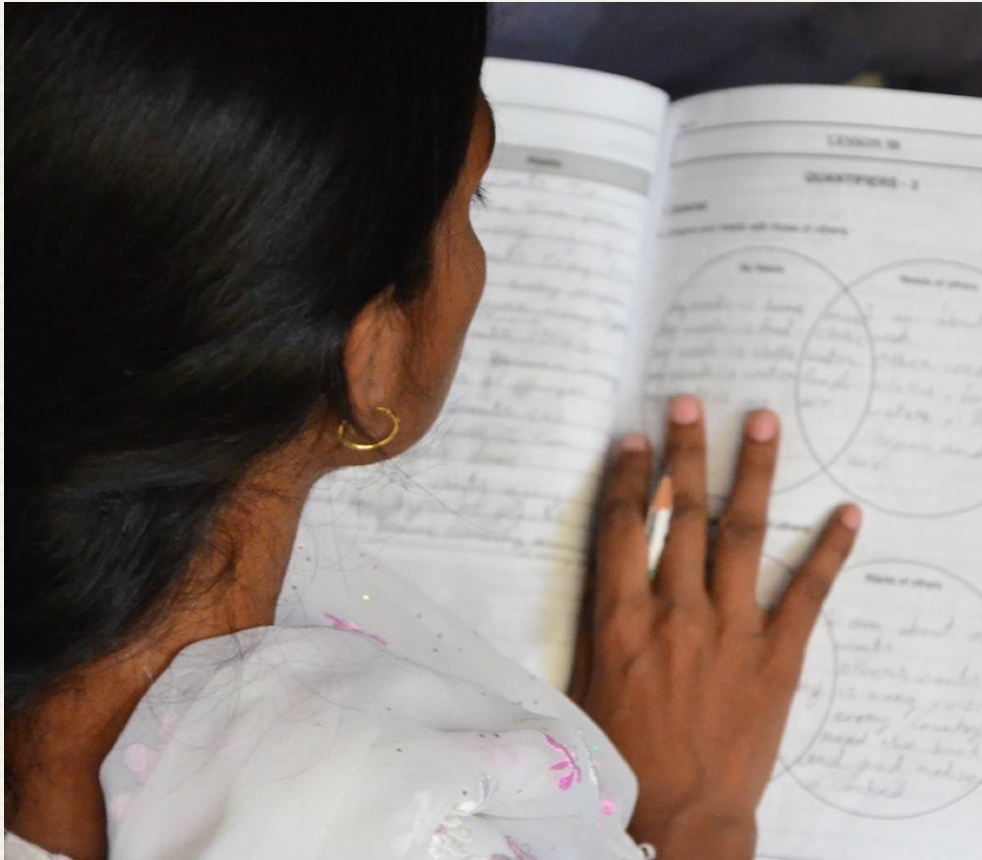
