For the duration of the training program all meals are provided.





Lotus Temple

Qutab Minar

Qutab Minar is a soaring, 73 meter high tower of victory, built in 1193 by Qutab-ud-din Aibak immediately after the defeat of Delhi's last Hindu kingdom. The tower has five distinct story's, each marked by a projecting balcony and tapers from a 15 m diameter at the base to just 2.5m at the top.

India Gate

At the centre of New Delhi stands the 42 m high India Gate, The memorial bears the names of more than 13,516 British and Indian soldiers killed in the Northwestern Frontier in the Afghan war of 1919. Another memorial, Amar Jawan Jyoti was added much later, after India got its independence.
