

BEWARE OF THEFT

AAMF Policy

- In case of a theft at the Center, an FIR is lodged with the police.

Impact of Theft

On Students

- If the police suspects any student of being involved, he/she will be called to the police station for questioning.
- The police may the search suspected student's house to recover the stolen item.
- If they think that you may have knowledge of the theft, they will call you to the police station for questioning.
- If the missing item is found in your possession, you may be sent to jail or a juvenile correctional home.

Telling the police that the stolen laptop has been given by a friend will not help

Families of Students

It will be very embarrassing for the family if a student is called to the police station or the police visits a student's house during the course of the investigation.

The Centre

- The center will lose an asset and students will be deprived of a valuable opportunity to learn.
- The police can come to the center at any time to investigate the theft, causing disruption of classes.
- The reputation of the center will be compromised as it will be seen as a place where students are indulging in crime and mischief.

Responsibilities of Students

- If you notice a classmate or someone acting suspiciously in the Center, please inform your facilitator immediately.
- If you know the person who has stolen the item, convince him to return it. If he/she accepts his/her mistake and returns the stolen item, we will not file the FIR.
- Follow AAMF protocols do not bring your bags into the room with computers.
- If you are the laptop monitor, perform your work in a serious and responsible manner, everyday.
